Overview

Dr. Anand Dharaskar is the foremost best urologist in Baner, Pune who has done MBBS from Government Medical College Nagpur in the year 1997, M.S General Surgery from Government Medical College, Nagpur in the year 2002, MRCS in the year 2005, MCH from SGPIMER, Lucknow in the year 2010. He stood second in All India Entrance Tests for SGPGIMS, which is an Institute of National Importance for Urology. Since then he has worked with a top hospital in Pune where he established a Renal Transplant Program and Laser Prostatectomy (HoLEP). He was an Honorary Urologist in YCM, Pimpri, Pune for 2 years as a social responsibility towards poor and needy patients. Dr. Anand is currently associated as a consultant with the Department of Urology at Manipal Hospital Baner. He is fluent in Hindi, English and Marathi, this linguistic ability allows him to communicate effectively with the patients and create a customised treatment plan that focuses on holistic and faster healing. His areas of expertise include: Urology and Renal Transplant, REZUM, UROLIFT, Endourology including laser prostatectomy (HoLEP), bipolar TURP for BPH/ prostate, RIRS/ flexible ureteroscopy, Supine / miniPCNL for staghorn calculus, Flexible cystoscopy diagnosis and stent removal, TRUS guided prostate biopsy for prostate cancer, Laparoscopic urology like lap nephrectomy, lap pyeloplasty, lap radical nephrectomy or prostatectomy, Laparoscopic CAPD catheter insertion for dialysis at home, Uro-oncology surgery like radical nephrectomy and radical prostatectomy radical cystectomy, surgery for penile and testicular tumours. Dr. Anand is the winner of UROQUIZ at NZUSICON 2010, demonstrated LIVE HoLEP surgery at the National Conference, and also received an award for a talk on post-kidney transplant complications and management multiple times at the National Conferences and workshops.
