Overview

Dr. Shivakumar Varakanahalli is an experienced gastroenterologist in Budigere, Bangalore. He is currently practising as a Consultant – Gastroenterology at Manipal Clinics Budigere Cross, Bangalore, providing expert consultations for a wide spectrum of gastrointestinal and liver-related conditions. Known for his compassionate care and methodical clinical approach, Dr. Shivakumar works closely with patients to diagnose and manage concerns such as acid reflux, chronic diarrhoea, functional bowel disorders, and inflammatory conditions like ulcerative colitis and Crohn's disease. His expertise extends to pancreatic disorders, hepatology, and the clinical management of liver diseases, including hepatitis, cirrhosis, and fatty liver. Dr. Shivakumar's medical training began with an MBBS from Mysore Medical College and Research Institute in Karnataka. He went on to complete his MD in General Medicine from Rabindranath Tagore Medical College, Rajasthan, followed by a DM in Gastroenterology from the esteemed GB Pant Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research, New Delhi. This rigorous academic and clinical training has shaped his deep understanding of digestive health and equipped him with the confidence to handle complex diagnostic scenarios. During his residency and fellowship years, Dr. Shivakumar developed significant experience in diagnostic and therapeutic endoscopy, performing over 500+ ERCPs and more than 1,000+ endoscopic procedures. At Budigere Clinic, Dr. Shivakumar provides specialised gastroenterology consultations with a focus on personalised care. His areas of interest include chronic liver diseases, gastrointestinal bleeding, irritable bowel syndrome, dyspepsia, and constipation. He also evaluates cases of pancreatic inflammation and biliary conditions through clinical history, physical examination, and appropriate diagnostic tools, advising patients on lifestyle modifications, medical management, and referrals for advanced care, when necessary. His careful, evidence-based approach and clear communication style have earned the trust of patients seeking answers to long-standing digestive complaints. Dr. Shivakumar is actively involved in academic research and has contributed to numerous peer-reviewed journals. His studies have explored a wide range of gastrointestinal and hepatic topics. Notably, his research on the secondary prophylaxis of hepatic encephalopathy through L-ornithine L-aspartate was presented at the International Liver Congress 2018 in Paris, earning him the Young Investigator Award. His oral presentation at INASL 2017, focusing on hepatic encephalopathy management, received a plenary award. Dr. Shivakumar has authored several influential papers, including those examining spontaneous pseudocystocolonic fistula, the role of endoscopic ultrasound in bile duct evaluation, and Brunner's gland hamartoma as a cause of upper gastrointestinal bleeding. His work has been published in leading journals such as the Journal of Clinical and Experimental Hepatology, European Journal of Gastroenterology and Hepatology, and Indian Journal of Gastroenterology. Fluent in English, Kannada, and Hindi, he offers a culturally sensitive and inclusive approach to patients visiting Budigere Clinic, where he serves as a trusted advisor for long-term digestive and liver care.
