### Overview

Dr. Soumya Dingal is a Consultant in the Department of Emergency Medicine at Manipal Hospitals, E.M. Bypass, Kolkata, with extensive experience in critical care and emergency response. He holds an M.D. in Physician (2007), MEM(GWU-USA) -2014, PGDQMHHO (2003), and an MBA (2023), PGDMLS (2023), reflecting a strong academic and operational foundation in emergency healthcare management. As a certified instructor in Basic Life Support (BLS), Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS), and Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS), and a provider of NALS and ATLS, Dr. Dingal is equipped to handle complex, high-pressure cases with precision. His clinical expertise includes advanced airway management such as endotracheal intubation and cricothyrotomy (surgical and needle), ventilator operations, central venous catheter insertion via internal jugular, subclavian, and femoral routes—with or without ultrasound guidance—along with chest tube insertion and pericardiocentesis. He is proficient in temporary pacemaker insertion (TPI), arterial line placement, FAST scans, orthopedic emergency management including POP slab applications and joint dislocations (shoulder, knee, hip), pleural and peritoneal tapping, nasogastric tube placement, urinary catheterization, arterial sampling, IV cannulation, wound closure, suturing, lumbar puncture, emergency delivery, and foreign body removal. Dr. Dingal is also experienced in thrombolytic therapy for stroke (CVA) and myocardial infarction (MI), pediatric umbilical vein and artery catheter (UVC & UAC) insertions, abscess incision and drainage, and a wide range of surgical emergency interventions.
