She designed competency-based curricula, trained residents, and conducted didactic lectures, ECG interpretation workshops, journal clubs, and bedside clinical sessions. In her clinical practice, Dr. Shaama has gained broad exposure in diagnosing and managing a range of acute and chronic conditions such as diabetes, hypertension, thyroid disorders, and infectious diseases.
