Overview

Dr. Sreevalli A is a medical oncologist in Kanakapura Road, Bangalore, currently practising as a Consultant - Medical Oncology at Manipal Hospital Kanakapura Road. With a strong academic background and wide-ranging clinical experience, Dr. Sreevalli has established herself as a top cancer specialist offering personalised and evidence-based care to patients across all stages of malignancy. Her areas of clinical focus span solid tumours, haematological malignancies, immunotherapy, and precision oncology. Dr. Sreevalli completed her MBBS from Sri Shamanur Shivashankarappa Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Davangere. She then pursued her MD in General Medicine from St. John's Medical College, Bangalore, where she graduated with distinction and was honoured as the Best Outgoing Student in the Department of General Medicine. She stood fourth rank to Rajiv Gandhi University, Karnataka. Her academic excellence continued with a DM in Medical Oncology from the Kidwai Memorial Institute of Oncology, Bengaluru. During her DM, she secured the Gold Medal for achieving the first rank to Rajiv Gandhi university across the state of Karnataka. In addition, she holds the prestigious MRCP UK Speciality Certificate in Medical Oncology and is ESMO (European Society Of Medical Oncology) Certified. Her clinical training is complemented by extensive real-world experience. Dr. Sreevalli has served in both rural and urban healthcare settings. Early in her career, she provided primary healthcare in underserved regions near Davangere. She worked as a Senior Medical Registrar in Medical Oncology and later as a Consultant at a dedicated cancer hospital, where she led outpatient and inpatient oncology services and oversaw chemotherapy, immunotherapy, and palliative care pathways. Dr. Sreevalli has actively contributed to the field of oncology through her involvement in international multicentre clinical trials, serving as Co-Principal Investigator in multiple phase 1, 2, and 3 oncology studies. These include advanced studies on metastatic breast cancer, prostate cancer, and relapsed advanced malignancies. Her research interests include real-world outcomes in cancer therapeutics, immunotherapy and molecular profiling of tumours. Her publications in reputed journals such as the Journal of the National Comprehensive Cancer Network, Indian Journal of Cancer, Indian Journal of Medical and Paediatric Oncology, and Cancer Research, Statistics & Treatment reflect her deep commitment to oncology research. An accomplished presenter, Dr. Sreevalli has delivered oral and poster presentations at both national and global conferences. She was awarded a travel grant for her oral presentation titled "SUBCUTANEOUS PHESGO: THE WAY AHEAD INTO THE FUTURE" at the Indian Cancer Congress 2023. She was one among three Indians selected for the IASLC Academy 2025, a prestigious global programme recognising excellence in lung cancer care and research, with only 35 oncologists selected worldwide. Her case presentations on complex haematological and solid malignancies have been showcased at the NCCN Conference Florida 2024, European School of Haematology, ISMPOCON, ICON, Immuno-Oncology Society of India congresses, and Indian Cancer Congress. Dr. Sreevalli's academic contributions include many original research publications and multiple journal reviews. She has served as a reviewer for journals such as IJMPO, CRST, JENCI, and IRJO, and was named the Second Best IJMPO Trainee Reviewer at ISMPOCON 2022. Her keen eye for clinical detail and critical analysis makes her a trusted academic contributor in oncology. Dr. Sreevalli is a strong advocate for cancer awareness and education. She regularly engages in public health outreach through newspaper articles, television and radio segments, and guest lectures at medical colleges and corporate forums. Her outreach work plays a vital role in demystifying cancer, promoting early detection, and supporting preventive health measures.
