He is deeply versed in cognitive-behavioural therapy (CBT), supportive psychotherapy, family counselling, and holistic approaches that address emotional and behavioural aspects. He also offers community psychiatric services, such as premarital and family counselling, adolescent psychiatry, dementia care, migraine management, and innovative community psychiatry programmes. Acknowledged as a thought leader, Dr. Vikram Arunachalam was recognised by the Government of Karnataka and National Health Mission for pioneering psychiatry integration in Primary Health Centres (PHCs) across Karnataka under the District Mental Health Programme (DMHP).
