Overview

Dr. Mahadev Abhishek M is a top cancer surgeon in Bangalore, currently practicing as an Associate Consultant - Surgical Oncology at Manipal Hospital, Millers Road. His field of expertise includes Gastrointestinal and Minimal Access Surgical Oncology, Breast Cancer Surgery (including organ conservation, oncoplasty, and sentinel node techniques), and ERAS (Enhanced Recovery After Surgery) protocols. With a strong record of research and academic contributions, Dr. Mahadev ensures innovative, evidence-based care to patients from diverse regions. He is a top cancer surgeon in Millers Road. On the academic front, Dr. Mahadev completed his MBBS at Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute in 2011. He then pursued an MS in General Surgery from Jawaharlal Nehru Medical College, Belgaum in 2016. Driven to further specialize in cancer surgery, Dr. Mahadev advanced his training by earning an MCh in Surgical Oncology from Kidwai Memorial Institute of Oncology, Bangalore, in 2022. His research during this period emphasised innovative approaches in oncologic surgery, and his dissertation work received national recognition by being accepted by the National Board of Examinations. Dr. Mahadev also gained practical experience in minimally invasive techniques in cancer care during a 6-month Fellowship in Minimal Invasive Surgical Oncology, where he assisted in laparoscopic and robotic GI cancer surgeries. Dr. Mahadev's work experience is marked by progressive responsibility. His career as a fellow/registrar in surgical oncology honed his skills in laparoscopic and robotic procedures. He subsequently served as a Senior Resident in General Surgery and as a Registrar in General Surgery, roles that allowed him to refine his surgical decision-making and patient management skills. He is also involved in training the next generation of surgeons and driving clinical research during his stint at various organisations. Dr. Mahadev has an impressive record of academic contributions. He has presented numerous papers and posters at national conferences, with topics ranging from unusual cases of cancer to advanced techniques in surgical management. Notable presentations include his award-winning oral paper on a rare case of chest wall tumours and a poster presentation on locally advanced urachal adenocarcinoma, which reflect his commitment to sharing clinical insights and advancing oncologic practice. These scholarly contributions have solidified his reputation as a thought leader in surgical oncology. Dr. Mahadev is also actively involved in volunteer and community activities, having participated in free clinics and medical camps during his training. He remains committed to serving the community and improving access to quality cancer care. His dedication to clinical excellence, research, and teaching underscores his commitment to evidence-based medicine and continuous improvement in oncologic surgery.
