Dr. Shabber Zaveri is the Chairman, HOD, and Consultant - Surgical Oncology at Manipal Hospital Old Airport Road, Bangalore. With over 31 years of experience and an impressive academic foundation, Dr. Zaveri has earned his reputation as a trusted medical expert in the field of Surgical Oncology. Dr. Zaveri stands out as a proficient Oncologist with expertise across diverse oncological areas. His field of expertise lies in the care of Oncoplastic Breast Surgery, Head and Neck Cancers, HIPEC and PIPAC, Sarcoma, Lung and Mediastinal Tumour Resections, General Surgical Oncology, Gastrointestinal Malignancy, and Gynaec Oncology. He is a top oncology surgeon in Bangalore. Dr. Shabber Zaveri has contributed significantly to the field of oncology. He was instrumental in establishing the Department of Surgical Oncology at Manipal Hospital Old Airport Road, Bangalore in 2002. Dr. Shabber introduced the Sentinel Lymph Node Biopsy for Breast Cancer in 2004 and pioneered the Radioisotope Occult Lesion Localization (ROLL) for Breast Cancer treatment in 2005. Notably, he was among the first medical professionals in India to initiate Minimally Invasive Radio Guided Para Thyroid surgeries (MIRP). He also launched the HIPEC Program in 2013 at Manipal Hospital Bengaluru. Dr. Shabber Zaveri completed his MBBS from Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute, MS in General Surgery from B J Medical College Ahmedabad, and M.Ch in Surgical Oncology from The Gujarat Cancer and Research Institute. Notably, he has secured fellowships in Robotic Surgery at Hackensack Medical Center, New Jersey; Thoracic Surgery from Fachkrankenhaus, Dresden, Germany; Breast Surgical Oncology at the Memorial Sloan Kettering Cancer Centre, New York; Cytoreductive Surgery and HIPEC from the European Institute of Surgery, Hamburg, Germany and PIPAC from St. Elizebeth Hospital, Germany. In addition to his fellowships, Dr. Shabber Zaveri maintains active memberships in several esteemed medical associations. These include the Association of Surgeons of India, IASO Indian Association of Oncology, European Society of Surgical Oncology, European Society of Medical Oncology, and the American Society of Clinical Oncology, among many others. Notably, Dr. Zaveri delivered the Professor Ramdoss Oration on Radioguided Surgery in Oncology in September 2009 during the Society of Nuclear Medicine in India's Annual Conference. With a career marked by dedication, innovation, and a commitment to excellence, Dr. Shabber Zaveri is known to be one of the best surgical oncologists in Bangalore and India.
