She is also highly skilled in treating strokes, from acute ischaemic events to long-term rehabilitation planning, ensuring optimal recovery and prevention of future episodes. Dr. Richa also specialises in movement disorders, offering comprehensive care for conditions such as Parkinson's disease, essential tremor, and dystonia. Her interest in neuromuscular disorders spans myasthenia gravis, peripheral neuropathy, and muscular dystrophies. She is proficient in conducting and interpreting neurophysiological tests like nerve conduction studies and electromyography, which are essential for accurate diagnosis and treatment planning. She uses a multidisciplinary approach to improve quality of life through medications, lifestyle guidance, and coordinated therapy. Her management of epilepsy includes seizure classification, medication optimisation, and patient education, with a goal of achieving long-term seizure control and safety.
