His research focuses on areas such as endoscopic approaches to hematomas, spontaneous occlusion of aneurysms, and the treatment of dural arteriovenous malformations. These contributions have been presented at several national and international conferences, helping to expand neurosurgical knowledge, particularly in minimally invasive techniques. Dr. Chakraborty, the best brain specialist in Kolkata, has also contributed to numerous high-impact neurosurgical journals, publishing case reports on endoscopic hematoma evacuation, surgical techniques for rare tumors, and complex cerebrovascular conditions. His research on minimally invasive approaches has been widely praised for its potential to reduce patient recovery times and guide surgeons toward less invasive methods.
