His dedication towards paediatric critical care led him to secure the Indian Diploma in Paediatric Critical Care Medicine (IDPCCM), followed by a specialised Fellowship in Paediatric Intensive Care in London, UK. This deeply enriched his expertise in handling complex paediatric ICU cases, advanced ventilation, cardiac critical care, and emergency paediatric stabilisation with globally aligned standards. His clinical experience is marked by exposure to diverse, high-acuity paediatric critical care settings. As a Senior Clinical Fellow in the Paediatric and Cardiac Intensive Care Units in London, he trained at an internationally recognised centre known for paediatric cardiac and respiratory care excellence. Prior to joining Manipal Hospital Varthur as a Consultant, he served in PICUs of established tertiary hospitals, where he managed some of the most challenging cases involving multi-organ dysfunction, severe infections, post-surgical recovery, ECMO-supported care, paediatric transplants, and life-threatening emergencies. He has authored and published work on rare neurological presentations in children and continues to remain active in research, reflecting his commitment to evolving paediatric critical care standards. Dedicated to continuous professional growth, he is currently pursuing additional qualifications in Paediatric Pulmonology and Paediatric Sleep Medicine, further expanding his scope of holistic paediatric care. Dr. Saurodip is known for his warm rapport with children and deeply supportive counselling with families, particularly during critical illness, prolonged ICU stays, or emotionally challenging diagnoses. His approach combines clinical precision with humane communication, helping families feel informed, guided, and reassured throughout their child's treatment journey. His strong belief in multidisciplinary care, evidence-based medicine, and parental involvement in the care plan reflects his vision of building a child-centred, integrated model of paediatric critical care at Manipal Hospital Varthur Road.
