Dr. B. K. Deepak is an experienced anaesthesiologist in Vijayawada, currently practising as a Consultant – Anaesthesia, Pain & Palliative Care at Manipal Hospital Vijayawada. With over a decade of advanced clinical experience in perioperative anaesthesia, cancer pain management, and interventional pain therapies Dr. Deepak is widely recognised for his expertise in ultrasound-guided nerve blocks, complex regional anaesthesia techniques, and comprehensive palliative care for patients with chronic and oncologic pain. Dr. Deepak completed his MBBS from Narayana Medical College, Andhra Pradesh, followed by MD in Anaesthesiology from Kasturba Medical College, Manipal, where he underwent rigorous training in critical care, airway management, and operative anaesthesia across high-volume surgical departments. To expand his specialization in pain medicine, he pursued the Fellowship in Interventional Pain Management (FIPM) from Daradia Pain Hospital, Kolkata, and the Fellowship in Palliative Medicine (FCPM) from Pallium India, Trivandrum. These fellowships strengthened his proficiency in interventional pain techniques, regenerative therapies, and advanced palliative protocols for complex cancer pain. Across his professional journey, from Junior Resident to Senior Resident, Specialist, Associate Consultant, and now Consultant at Manipal Hospital Vijayawada, Dr. Deepak has managed anaesthetic care for a wide range of surgical cases, including oncologic surgeries, neurosurgery, urology, orthopaedics, laparoscopic procedures, robotic surgeries, and high-risk emergencies. He is adept in general anaesthesia, neuraxial blocks, regional anaesthesia, labour analgesia, sedation protocols, and difficult airway management. His extensive experience includes CVP line placement, arterial line catheterisation, and ultrasound-guided procedures performed with high accuracy and safety. As an interventional pain specialist, Dr. Deepak offers a comprehensive spectrum of advanced procedures such as ozone nucleolysis for disc disease, transforaminal epidural steroid injections, SI joint and facet joint blocks, medial branch blocks, radiofrequency ablation (RFA), cooled RFA, cryoablation, and ultrasound-guided nerve entrapment treatments. He also performs regenerative therapies including PRP and BMAC injections for osteoarthritis, tendon injuries, ligament tears, plantar fasciitis, and De Quervain's tenosynovitis. In the domain of palliative care, he provides targeted pain relief for cancer patients using pharmacological and interventional approaches such as sympathetic blocks, coeliac plexus block, splanchnic block, and hypogastric plexus interventions under ultrasound and fluoroscopic guidance. He has authored impactful research, including studies published in the Middle East Journal of Anaesthesiology, the International Journal of Medicine and Public Health, and the Journal of Contemporary Clinical Practice. His work covers emergence agitation, TAP block analgesia, and ketamine use in opioid-refractory cancer pain. He has also presented widely at national anaesthesia conferences, including ISA, ISAAPCON, and various academic programmes. Dr. Deepak is actively involved in teaching and mentoring, conducting formal classes for undergraduate and postgraduate students, and training DNB Anaesthesia residents at Manipal Hospital for more than three years. His teaching approach blends clinical precision with real-world case insights, fostering strong practical learning for young clinicians. With professional affiliations that include the Indian Society of Anaesthesiologists (ISA), Indian Medical Association (IMA), and Indian Society for the Study of Pain (ISSP), he remains committed to continuous learning and contribution to the field.
